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## FEE POLICY

- For your convenience we accept the following forms of payment: debit, certified cheque, bank draft and all major credit cards. We cannot accept cash or personal cheques.
- Medication costs are not included and cannot be returned or refunded once purchased. See the Medication Fee Schedule for pricing.
- For Igenomix Testing, see Igenomix Fee Schedule.
- All fees are in Canadian dollars.

## CANCELLED OR CONVERTED CYCLE COSTS

- Cycles may be cancelled.
- Private IVF cancelled and not converted to IUI will be charged only the cycle monitoring fee of \$725.

## REFUND POLICY

- Outstanding credits can be refunded or utilized towards future cycles.
- In certain cases, the desired outcomes may not be achieved yet our fees are non-refundable.
- You will be reimbursed any fees for services not provided.
- Egg retrieval with no eggs will be refunded \$2,000 of the IVF treatment cycle fee.

**Full payment of fees is due when patients initiate treatment cycle (cycle day 3).**
